What is the French Bridge program?

- Statewide initiative in Utah allowing advanced university language courses to be taught in high school at a very low cost, during an entire school year.
- 3000 level courses of 3 credits each.
- Students can receive up to 9 college credits counting towards a major / minor in any of the 5 state universities in Utah.
- Courses taught in high school by both a university instructor and the high school teacher.
- Any student enrolled in grades 9, 10, or 11 who has successfully passed the AP exam with a minimum of a 3 can enroll in this courses.
- Students must receive a C or higher to receive university credits.

How much does it cost?

- Tuition in Fall 2020: a 3-credit course at the University of Utah costs **\$1,835**, and 9 credits cost **\$3,292**
- The price tag per Bridge credit is \$5, so \$15 a course, and \$45 for 9 credits.
